



Animal Rights Agenda

Published in Animals' Agenda magazine in November 1987

11. We call for an end to the use of animals in entertainment and sports such as dog racing, dog and cock fighting, fox hunting, hare coursing, rodeos, circuses, and other spectacles and a critical reappraisal of the use of animals in quasi-educational institutions such as zoos and aquariums.





Animal Liberation

"A liberation movement is a demand for an end to prejudice...I ask you to recognize that your attitudes to members of other species are a form of prejudice no less objectionable than prejudice about a person's race or sex."

Implementing the animal rights agenda requires fundamental change in the US legal system

- If animals have rights, their keepers can no longer be owners.
- People who keep animals must be guardians, not owners.
- Ownership responsibility becomes assigned to the government.

 - Anti-animals in education
 - Anti-animals in entertainment, sports and performance events

PETA's vision for companion animals

We must abolish companion animal breeds and restrict animals in the home to "refugees from the animal shelters and the streets... But, as the surplus of dogs and cats (artificially engineered by centuries of forced breeding) decline, eventually companion animals would be phased out, and we would return to a more symbiotic relationship – enjoyment at a distance."

Extremism looks crazy but it is often rational and strategic


- Extremists try to provoke target into a disproportionate response that radicalizes or at least changes the beliefs of moderates.
- The attack is designed to shift the balance of power to <u>produce a better bargaining</u> <u>position</u> at some time in the distant future.
 Moderates like to compromise.
- Extremist acts are designed to "move the middle" in the direction of radical change, an inch at a time if necessary, incrementally.







Image of dog breeding today









End breed specific legislation in Michigan by urging lawmakers to support SB 239!

Senate Bill 239 would prohibit any county, city, or town from enacting new or enforcing current laws that are "based solely on the breed, perceived breed, or type of dog." Prohibition of breed specific legislation protects an individual's property rights in their interest to responsibly own the dog of their choice.

Legislation – NAIA Trust

- Tracked more than 1000 bills last year
- Worked more than 100 bills last year
 - Provided expert legislative analysis;
 - Distributed alerts to grassroots;
 - Made contact with grasstops and allies;
 - Wrote letters to lawmakers;
 - Drafted model legislation;
 - Testified;
 - Did numerous radio and TV talk shows;
 - Initiated our own legislation, and
 - Prevailed in most battles.
