American Graded Stakes Committee

The purpose of the American Graded Stakes Committee is to provide owners and breeders of Thoroughbred horses a reliable guide to the relative quality of Thoroughbred bloodstock by identifying those U.S. races whose recent renewals have consistently attracted the highest quality competition.

American Graded Stakes Committee - History

- The grading of races began as a TOBA project in 1973, primarily at the request of European authorities anxious that North America have a method, similar to their Pattern race system implemented in 1972, for identifying the highest quality black-type events.
- In 1981 international auction houses and national breeders organizations and racing authorities formed the International Cataloguing Standards Committee “to achieve uniformity of cataloguing standards throughout the world,” recognizing the TOBA North American Graded Stakes Committee as the grading authority for North American races.



Committee Composition

- The TOBA American Graded Stakes Committee comprises 11 members: six TOBA Members, appointed by TOBA's chairman and confirmed by its trustees, with three-year terms three of which may be consecutive and five Racing Official Members, elected by the six TOBA Members, with three-year terms three of which may be consecutive.
- Representing TOBA: Everett Dobson (chairman), Barbara Banke, Reynolds Bell, Jr., Craig Bernick, Walker Hancock, and J. Michael O'Farrell.
- Racing Official Members: Kevin Greely, Ben Huffman, Steve Lym, Martin Panza, and Tom Robbins.



Criteria for Eligibility

- Meets minimum purse requirements - \$75,000 for eligible and Listed and once graded, \$100,000 for Grade III, \$200,000 for Grade II and \$300,000 for Grade I
- Has been run two consecutive prior years with materially the same conditions
- Satisfies objective criteria for graded races for its age/sex/distance division
- Is not restricted other than for non-winners of a sweepstakes
- Meets or exceeds guidelines in the committee's drug testing protocol
- Adoption of certain Association of Racing Commissioners International model rules on medication

Grading Divisions

The committee grades races in 15 divisions, evaluating the quality of the field of each eligible race in a given division relative to the quality of the field of other races in that division. These divisions are:

- 1) Two-year-olds (2YO)
- 2) Two-year-old Fillies (2YO F)
- 3) Three-year-old Route, Dirt (3YO R D)
- 4) Three-year-old Route, Turf (3YO R T)
- 5) Three-year-old Sprint (3YO SPR)
- 6) Three-year-old Filly Route, Dirt (3YO F R D)
- 7) Three-year-old Filly Route, Turf (3YO F R T)
- 8) Three-year-old Filly Sprint (3YO F SPR)
- 9) Three-year-old & Up Route, Dirt (3&UP R D)
- 10) Three-year-old & Up Route, Turf (3&UP R T)
- 11) Three-year-old & Up Sprint (3&UP SPR)
- 12) Three-year-old & Up Fillies & Mares Route, Dirt (3&UP F/M R D)
- 13) Three-year-old & Up Fillies & Mares Route, Turf (3&UP F/M R T)
- 14) Three-year-old & Up Fillies & Mares Sprint (3&UP F/M SPR)
- 15) Three-year-old & Up Sprint Turf (3&UP SPR T)

Grading Information

- Information supplied to the members of the committee includes statistical data for the last five years for all eligible races indicating quality of the field based on 1) points assigned for best performance in unrestricted black type stakes; 2) percentage of graded stakes winners in the field; 3) quality points achieved; 4) the official charts of the five most recent renewals; 5) North American Rating Committee (NARC) Ratings; and (6) Thoro-Graph figures.
- Members are expected to utilize this data, together with the knowledge drawn from their own experience, to make individual judgments as to the relative merit of the eligible races.

Sample Workbook Race Page

Each race has two pages in the divisional workbooks, a summary page with the chart of the most current renewal and a second page with the charts of the prior four renewals.

Points

Each horse is assigned a Point value based upon its best performance 24 months before or after the race in question, including performance in the renewal of the race under consideration, as follows:

- Six (6) Points:** **Grade I Stakes Winner**
- Four (4) Points:** **Grade II Stakes Winner
or Second in Grade I**
- Three (3) Points:** **Grade III Stakes Winner
or Second in Grade II or
Third in Grade I**
- Two (2) Points:** **Won a Listed or Listed
Restricted Stakes or
Second in Grade III or
Third in Grade II**
- One (1) Point:** **Won a non-Listed Grade
Eligible Stakes or an
open non-Listed Black
Type Stakes or Second
in a Listed Stakes or
Third in Grade III**

Quality Points

For each renewal the number of runners in the field which in the 24 months before or after the race in question, including the race in question, won a Grade I race (G1 Quality Point); a Grade I or Grade II race (G2 Quality Point); a Grade I, Grade II, or Grade III race (G3 Quality Point); only the highest win-level is recognized.

NARC Rates

This number serves as an expression of each race-renewal's quality based on past performances of horses in the field as evaluated by the North American Rating Committee (NARC). For 2019, NARC is a panel of racing secretaries, each of whom every week assigns a hypothetical weight ("Rating") to every horse competing in North American open stakes races and stakes races with the non-winners of a sweepstakes condition with a purse of at least \$75,000.

The NARC RATE for each renewal of the race under consideration is derived by allocating to each runner in the field the highest NARC rating achieved by that runner in the year of that renewal and averaging the highest four allocated NARC Ratings.

Voting

- Races highlighted in red (downgrade) or green (upgrade) on a divisional index must be discussed by the committee. In addition, any committee member can request a discussion and vote on any race.
- Eight affirmative votes are required to upgrade any race and six affirmative votes are required to downgrade a race.
- In the end, the workbooks and other information represent the committee's latest best effort to provide itself with the least imperfect array of "hard data" to aid, inform, and support an evaluation process that must finally depend on the integrity, experience, and judgment of the committee members themselves. The calculations can supplement, but cannot supplant, the collective wisdom of the committee. The grades are a composite of expert opinion, rather than the result solely of statistical analyses.

At the beginning of the 2019 grading session, 186, or 41.5%, of the graded races are turf races.
