Background – the gateway

☐ For some time, Tabcorp had been searching for an alternate solution for the development of global co-mingling. ☐ Apart from co-mingling domestically in Australia, Tabcorp commenced international co-mingling in 2007 with New Zealand. ☐ Since then, this has been extended to both South Africa and Singapore. ☐ In an effort to expedite the time required and reduce the cost of engaging each new international partner, Tabcorp sought to partner in the creation of a global tote gateway. ☐ After considering several options, Tabcorp decided to enter into a JV with a trusted partner in the form of Phumelela, a South African based tote company. ☐ This extended the co-mingling arrangements to the Isle Of Man.

The PGI Business

- The business has actually been operated by Phumelela since 2006 with steadily growing profitability.
- For both Phumelela and Tabcorp it was a case of very similar objectives:
 - □ Create one international tote gateway to make it easier for international connectivity for major international operators.
 - Encourage the major international tote operators to be users and if necessary, joint owners.
 - □ Provide additional revenues to the operator's domestic racing industry.
- □ The business has evolved into Premier Gateway International (PGI) licensed in the Isle Of Man (IOM) and is jointly owned by Phumelela Gold Enterprises and Tabcorp.

Operations today

- ☐ Operates virtually 24 hours 7 days a week.
- ☐ Offers over 8 currencies for inclusion in co-mingled pools.
- ☐ Co-mingles wagers on some 240 tracks around the world.
- ☐ Co-mingles with major tote operators.
- ☐ Host tote of various soccer tote pools such as Soccer 4, Soccer 6 and Soccer 10.
