At The Races

- At The Races is the UK and Ireland's most watched dedicated horseracing channel
- Domestic and international broadcast rights to 28 UK tracks and all 27 Irish tracks
- Available in over 10 million UK and Irish homes and reaching
 1.2 million different viewers every month
- Rights include Royal Ascot, all 5 Irish classic race meetings and exclusive UK All Weather, winter flat racing







At The Races

- Partnerships with SIS, UK Tote, Scientific Games, TRNi
- Live US racing every night plus top races from France, Germany, Italy, Australia, Hong Kong, Japan and Dubai
- Over \$2 million UK and European bet turnover passed back into US pools every week
- Exports UK and Irish racing to over 20 countries worldwide



UK and Ireland

- 59 UK courses with over 1300 meetings
- 27 Irish courses with over 300 meetings
- UK is the 4th largest horseracing betting market in the world worth almost \$10 billion in 2000.
- Bookmaking market dominates in both UK and Ireland. UK Tote accounts for 4% of betting turnover at \$250 million / year








Betting Operators in the UK

- · 24 different bookmaker chains and numerous independents
- Top 4 control 85% of the horseracing betting market
- Shops are still the dominant betting channel at 70%. Internet, telephone and iDTV are all growing with daily racing coverage available free to view in homes on ATR
- Horseracing is by far the dominant sports wagering product in the UK





UK Racing Broadcast

- 8,000 betting shops distributed by SIS
- Terrestrial TV broadcast on BBC and Channel 4
- Cable / satellite broadcast by At The Races and Racing UK
- At The Races in 10 million homes reaching 1.2 million different individuals / month. Occasional simulcasts across Sky Sports
- Racing UK 35,000 subscribers







Exploiting the UK market

- Bookmakers becoming interested in handling international racing without liability
- TRNi places UK bookmaker turnover into rights holders' host Tote pools
- 70% of UK bookmaker market now signed to TRNi
- Over \$2 million per week passed back into US pools
- Demand for US racing set to grow as betting shops are allowed extended opening hours
- •ATR has proven to be an effective marketing platform for US racing







France

- Government controlled racing and betting monopoly PMU
- 6th largest horseracing betting market with turnover of \$8 billion in 2004
- 234 Trotting courses offer 1700 meetings
- 171 Flat and Jumps courses offer 1251 meetings
- Limited commingling opportunity due to technical issues



Italy

- Government controlled racing and betting monopoly Unire
- 8th largest horseracing betting market with turnover of \$3.5 billion in 2003
- 24 Trotting courses offer 1600 races
- 20 Flat courses offer 6000 races
- Proprietary Tote system is not ITSP compliant. Betting shops closed in the evening



Sweden

- •State run monopoly ATG.
- •11th Largest horse betting industry which is mainly built around trotting and the V75.
- •2003 Turnover was \$1.3 billion V75 was \$480 million.
- •32 Trotting Tracks 1151 Meetings
- •5 Gallop Tracks 80 Meetings
- Commingling is legal
- •Sell the V75 to Holland, Germany, and the USA
- •They do some local pools on big US harness events from Meadowlands.



Germany

- •17th largest horse betting industry.
- Predominantly a Bookmaker
- •German Tote, Direktorium, 50 shops.
- •12 Trotting Tracks 7,700 Races
- •42 Gallop Tracks 2,100 Races
- Direktorium planning to take US racing in 2006



Turkey and Greece

Turkey

- •Turkey is the 13th Largest horse betting industry turnover in 2000 of \$790 million
- •6 Gallop Tracks 2,600 races a year.
- •The have a government run tote monopoly with a take out rate up to 65%
- Betting on International races is Illegal

Greece

- •Greece is the 19th largest horse betting industry 2000 Turnover of \$323 million
- •Tote Monopoly Greek Organisation for Horse Racing (GOFHR)
- •No international racing, commingling is illegal.



Holland

- •\$61 million (€52 million) turnover 2004.
- Tote monopoly operated by Scientific Games Racing
- •5 Trotting Tracks 170 Meetings
- •1 Gallop Track 48 Meetings
- •Commingle with UK Tote, ATG, Germany, SAF Tote and US
- Non Commingled France
