Benefits of Commingling

- Provide customers with a superior product vis-à-vis separate pools
 - Larger pools / more handsome payout, especially on long-odds bets
 - More stable odds
- Increase business opportunities for guest and host tracks/operators
 - Incremental revenue on existing program for host
 - Low cost method to expand program and betting opportunity for guest
- Enlarge taxation base and income for both guest and host governments
- Help tackle illegal gambling situation
 - More competitive product
- Provide a legal channel to combat off-shore operators




Commingling with Macau – Overview

- Began in January 2005
- Partner (Guest): Macau Jockey Club (MJC)
- All Hong Kong races
 - MJC race on Friday and the other weekend day when Hong Kong is not racing
- Win, Place, Quinella and Quinella Place
 - Other pools are under discussion
- MJC / HKJC: Hong Kong Dollars
 - Customer / MJC: Hong Kong Dollars or Macau Pataca
- Gross pool pricing



Commingling with Macau - Technical Setup






Commingling with the U.S. – Overview

- Commingling began in September 2007
 - Separate pool since 1994
- Partner (Guest): Las Vegas Dissemination Company (LVDC)
- All Hong Kong races
- Win, Place, Quinella, Quinella Place, Double, Tierce, Trio, First 4
 - Double Trio, Triple Trio and Six Up by first quarter 2008
- LVDC / HKJC: Hong Kong Dollars
 - Customer / LVDC: U.S. Dollars
- Gross pool pricing




Commingling with the U.S. – Technical Setup

 Verification is done on ITGW by matching the Collation / Winner obtained via ITSP with Collation / Winner scan from transactions

On incoming side, HKJC is allowed to bring in 10 races into Hong Kong annually.



Hurdles and Issues: Others

- No credit betting: bank guarantee
- No outbound commingling
- Government approval of transactions
- Technical: system interface / protocol, security and integrity of transactions, pools / products
- Variations in operating standards, racing rules, betting rules and product features



Future Plans and Outlook

- Continue to develop the U.S. relationship
- Continue to develop the Macau relationship
- Develop current separate pool simulcast business into commingling arrangement



- Explore commingle opportunities in Europe and elsewhere
- Lobby for more favourable legislation
 - Competitive taxation scheme
 - More incoming simulcast opportunity
 - Relaxation of outbound commingling restriction
