Background

- Founded in 1842
- Today the only horse-racing club in Singapore
- Part of the Malayan Racing Association (MRA), which was formed in 1896 to regulate horse racing in Singapore and Malaysia
- STC, Selangor Turf Club, Penang Turf Club and Perak Turf Club



<u>Background</u>

- Cross-border racing and free movement of horses between Singapore & Malaysia until 1999's outbreak of the Nipah virus in Malaysia
- STC staged races on its own with horses based at the Singapore Racecourse@Kranji
- Recognized the need to explore overseas races beyond Malaysia in mid-2000s



Objectives

- Bring more world class racing and variety to Singapore fans
- 2. Expose and export Singapore Racing (or SR) to other parts of the world beyond MRA
- 3. Increase business collaborations and partnership through attracting international racing connections to Singapore and co-mingling of tote pools
- 4. Benefit financially to fuel Singapore Racing's growth
