

## NEW MEXICO GAMING CONTROL BOARD

- Established By Statute In 1997
  - Agreed Upon Relationship Between Compacts and "Limited" Non-Tribal Gaming
- Began Operations in July 1998
- Direct Regulation Of:
  - Legalized Gaming
    - Racetrack and Not For Profit Casinos
    - Bingo and Raffle
  - Oversight Of Tribal Compacts

## **Organizational Setup**

#### House Bill 399 Passed In The 1997 Session

- Primary Content
  - Increased Regulatory Fees
  - 16% Revenue Sharing
  - Legalization Of Video Gaming At Certain Non Profits And Racetracks
  - Mandated A Computerized Central Monitoring System

### Experience



- 5 Racetrack Casinos (All Built From Scratch!)
  - 4 in 1999
    - Sunland Park (8 Months From Inception Of The Board!)
    - Sunray Park (May)
    - Ruidoso Downs (July)
    - Albuquerque Downs (August)
  - 1 in 2004
    - Hobbs Zia Park
- 75 Not-For-Profit Casinos

#### CONCIDERATIONS

- Regulator Will Apply The Statute And Regulations To Every Situation!
  - In New Mexico
    - Must Have Racing License Before Casino License
    - Regulator Must Approve Your Plan!
      - Functional layout and Process Control
      - Security and Surveillance!
    - Regulator Must Be Involved!
      - Nuts to Bolts
  - MAKE THE REGULATOR YOUR PARTNER!

## **Special Considerations**

- An Operator Must...
  - Have A Thorough knowledge Of
    - Statutes
    - Rules and Regulations
    - Minimum Internal Control Documents
    - Policies and Procedures
    - Forms
  - Different In Each Jurisdiction!!!
